
Accessibility to Eindhoven

From Amsterdam Schiphol Airport

Schiphol Airport is the biggest airport in the Netherlands with hundreds of international flights every day. If you take a flight to Schiphol Airport, it is quite easy to reach Eindhoven. There is a train station inside the airport. And every 15 minutes you can find a train to Eindhoven. When you get off in Eindhoven Station, you are already in the middle of the city, where your hotel is most probably within walking distance.
